Before putting your pet under anesthesia, we perform a physical examination. In addition, we recommend a pre-operative blood panel to help identify potential problems, *which may not be evident physically*, that may require a change in anesthesia protocol. Please identify your choice below:

4. For Surgical Procedures please read the following:

Laser- we offer laser option for most surgical procedures (not dental cleaning). The benefits of a laser procedure are *less bleeding and decreased post-operative discomfort*. For spays, neuters, and declaws this is done at an additional cost of \$69.00. For other surgical procedures the additional cost ranges from \$79.00 to \$150.00.

5. We are now offering Sevoflurane:

Sevoflurane is an even safer inhaled anesthesia. It is shorter acting and highly recommended for older or high-risked patients. The additional cost for Sevoflurane is \$35.00

6. We offer an EKG to better monitor your pet while under anesthesia.

The EKG will monitor heart rate, respiratory rate, and oxygenation of the blood. The advantage of this is real time monitoring of your animal. We highly recommend this to patients who are at high risk, the elderly, and/or for any patient that you are concerned about handling anesthesia. The added charge for this is \$35.00.
